ABOUT THE PEOPLE

The Makhmi people number around 500,000 in India. They are a Tibetan people living in Pakistan and India.

They live in the northern mountainous regions of India and associate with many of the other peoples and groups located in the mountains of northern India.

Very little information is known about the Makhmi people. However, since they speak Urdu as their heart language, there are resources available to them. Prayer will be essential in reaching them with the Gospel.



PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for the Makhmi to begin to see the light offered in Jesus Christ.
- Pray that more information would be found and published about the Makhmi so that the church can pray and send more effectively.
- Ask God to raise up workers, both from India and around the world, to go and share the love of Christ with the Muslims of the Makhmi.
- Ask God to open up doors of opportunity for believers to share truth with those who need to hear.
- Pray that God would allow the Gospel message to be proclaimed in a way that the Makhmi would understand.
- Ask God to stir up the hearts of the Makhmi and that they might become discontent with their current beliefs.
